- 1. MFA Multi-Factor Authentication: An extra step to verify your identity.
- 2. Firewall Blocks unauthorized access to or from your network.
- 3. Phishing Fake emails designed to steal your data.
- 4. Malware Malicious software like viruses or ransomware.
- 5. Encryption Scrambles data to protect it from unauthorized access.
- 6. Patch A software update that fixes vulnerabilities.
- 7. VPN A secure tunnel for your internet connection.
- 8. Threat Actor Someone who causes or attempts to cause a cybersecurity incident.
- 9. Vulnerability A weakness that can be exploited by threats.
- 10. Zero Trust A security model that verifies everything before granting access.
